

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(ASHURST: PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO. 1872)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from proceeding along the length of Public Bridleway No. 1872 from its junction with Public Footpath No. 1873 (TQ165159), south-eastwards to its junction with Public Footpath No. 2591 (TQ168153), a distance of approximately 800 metres.


The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to an unsafe path surface.

Unfortunately, there is no alternative route available using the Public Rights of Way network.

The Order will come into effect on 4 March 2025 and will last for 6 months or until the proposed works are completed, whichever is earlier.
